and join together with peers and a trained parent tutor to discuss and practice together on the 5th day. The parents remain the primary teacher from K-high school.

We are a parent-participation group with a focus on providing content-rich elective-type classes for students in the arts, physical education, science, and spiritual disciplines. The Family Learning Program is a secular learning and community-building environment for homeschooling families in Seattle and beyond. Based in West Seattle and partnering with Seattle Parks and Recreation since 2010, our program offers a wide variety of classes, clubs, and community which complement diverse homeschooling methods. FLP serves over 70 families and has become a unique, welcoming, and growing presence in the Seattle homeschool community.

Our teachers are highly qualified and enjoy working with families and motivated learners in mixed-age groupings. Class sizes are small, typically capping at 8-12 students. In addition to offering fee-based classes, the program is open to all to come play, socialize and connect with other homeschooling families.
