

Transitioning Teens


For parents with students on the secondary level (grades 7-12), they are discovering that their teens' developmental clock begins to kick into a new stage requiring more autonomy. Spiritually, children move into the "age of accountability". Often, many homeschoolers quit during junior high or high school due to academic challenges and this individuation process. In the ancient Jewish tradition, rabbis came along side while the older child/teen still worked and lived at home, learned a trade, and prepared for adulthood. In our program, the Family Academy ® Teacher Consultant [TC] comes along side to help parents and teens make this transition.
